

# MEAL PLAN INFORMATION FOR WWU APARTMENT RESIDENTS AND OFF-CAMPUS BOARDERS 2008-2009 ACADEMIC YEAR

**GENERAL INFORMATION:** You may sign up for a meal plan at the Housing Assignments Office in Edens Hall 103. Meal plans will be sold only to students, faculty, administrators and staff of WWU. Meal plan holders may dine at any one of the three dining rooms (Viking Commons, Ridgeway and Fairhaven). **Dining hall hours are posted at each dining room.** Several different meal options have been made available to accommodate various eating patterns. **All meal plan contracts are for the entire academic year. To cancel a meal plan, the meal plan holder is required to complete the meal plan cancellation form at Housing Assignments Office, Edens Hall Suite 103, or by emailing your cancellation to [assignments@wwu.edu](mailto:assignments@wwu.edu). Include your name, student #, and date plan is to stop. The meal plan holder will be responsible for payment (based on prorated meals and meal plan daily rate) up through the date of written cancellation, regardless of the number of meals consumed. Meals or Dining Dollars used past the prorated amount will be billed separately to your student account. Late fees will be charged for delinquent accounts.** Housing Assignments Office hours are Monday-Friday, 8am-5pm. Housing Cashier hours are Monday-Friday, 9am-4pm.

**Unlimited Meal Plan:** Unlimited access to all meals for meal plan participants; plus \$150 "Dining Dollars" each quarter; plus 10 guest meals per Qtr.

**125 Meal Plan:** Any 125 meals per quarter for meal plan participants and guests accompanied by meal plan participants, plus \$150 "Dining Dollars" each quarter. Unused Dining Dollars roll over until the end of Spring Quarter.

**100 Meal Plan:** Any 100 meals per quarter for meal plan participants and guests accompanied by meal plan participants, plus \$150 "Dining Dollars" each quarter. Unused Dining Dollars roll over until the end of Spring Quarter

**75 meal Plan:** Any 75 meals per quarter for meal plan participants and guests accompanied by meal plan participants, plus \$150 "Dining Dollars" each quarter. Unused Dining Dollars roll over until the end of Spring Quarter

**MEALS SERVED:** Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner served Monday – Friday.  
Brunch and Dinner served Saturday and Sunday.

**MUNCH MONEY:** Available for purchase at the Housing Cashier Office in Edens Hall (9am-4pm, Monday-Friday) or at the University Cashier, Old Main 245 (9am-4pm, Monday-Friday).

**EARLY CANCELLATION/CHECKOUTS:** Meals, Dining Dollars, and guest meals are prorated for the number of days up through your cancellation or checkout date (date which keys are returned if Birnam Wood resident and are leaving your room) regardless of the number of meals consumed. Any meals or Dining Dollars used past the prorated amount will be billed separately to your student account. Dining Dollars for active meal plans can be used until the retail and residential dining units close each quarter.

**DINING ROOM ATMOSPHERE:** A university dining room is unlike any other eating situation in that it contains elements of the atmosphere present in both the home and the restaurant dining environments. The community nature of university dining is therefore unique. Not only do individuals purchase their own meals, but they must respect the rights of and cooperate with other diners in maintaining a clean and pleasant dining environment. We ask your cooperation in keeping the dining room one that everyone can enjoy.
