



Request for Deferral of Housing Prepayment

Incoming students who demonstrate a high level of financial need may qualify to have their housing prepayment deferred. Requests for deferral are granted only in cases of financial hardship and based upon your Pell Grant eligibility and the Student Aid Index (SAI)*.

Please note, deferral requests will only be considered for students who have been sent a letter offering housing. If you cancel housing after we have approved a Housing Prepayment Deferral, you may be responsible for repaying the prepayment in part or full out-of-pocket.

*After submitting the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form, you will be able to view the FAFSA Submission Summary, which lists your (SAI) and Pell Grant eligibility (if applicable). If you need assistance regarding your financial aid please contact the Financial Aid Department.

For general inquiries about the housing application, roommate manager, etc. please contact Housing at 360-650-6565. You can check on your Housing application status through the MyHousing portal. The Housing Business Office will contact you via your Western email when your deferral request has either been approved or denied.
