# WHAT: Project PW778A Birnam Wood Siding & Bridge Replacement—PHASE 1

WHEN: April 24, 2023 through September 8, 2023.

#### Work Schedule

- Monday through Friday: 8:00am 9:00am (no noise work) & 9:00am 7:30pm (noise work).
- Weekdays and Holidays: No work unless approved five (5) business days in advanced by UR.

WHERE: Work will be done at Birnam Wood Stack 3 (BW03), Stack 4 (BW04) & the Community Building (BC).

## Interior Work (BC)

Replace exterior windows and doors.

### Exterior Work (BW03, BW04, BC)

- Replace building cladding (siding) system.
- Replace pedestrian bridges at BW03 and BW04.

WHY: This project will address the following requirements.

- WWU is continuing improvements to the Birnam Wood Community in conjunction with a multiyear exterior building renovation plan that started in 2015.
- Previous efforts have upgraded exterior balconies, drainage, and roofing systems.
- The project now represents **PHASE 1** to address the following requirements.
  - Exterior cladding (siding) systems that is beyond rated useful life need to be replaced with new capabilities that are maintenance friendly, energy efficient, and conducive to student living.
  - o Deteriorated pedestrian bridges need to be replaced to provide reliable infrastructure.
  - Outdated exterior doors and windows need to be replaced with new, energy efficient units.
  - o <u>NOTE</u>: Phase 2 will address Stacks 5, 6, 7 and Phase 3 will address Stacks 1 & 2 along with the Remote Laundry Building.

#### STUDENT EXPERIENCE IMPACTS

- Construction noise, vibrations, other inconveniences may occur during noted work schedule hours.
- Scaffolding assembled around work buildings may impact outside visibility; residents need to exercise "mindful privacy" (closing window blinds) as appropriate during scheduled work hours.
- Parking slots may be reduced to accommodate Contractor staging areas located near work buildings.



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• Pedestrian and vehicle detours will be in place as needed; residents need to use caution and observe posted signage.
